Hosea ministered in Israel, 755-710 BC

Hosea had the difficult honor of having his life used as a living moral lesson for Israel. Instructed by God to marry a habitually unfaithful wife, Hosea spoke movingly and earnestly about God's sorry at Israel's worship of false gods and God's willingness to forgive.


